"She was very game today. She didn't want to get beat. I just wanted to make sure she stayed in front. She needed that last race. It made the difference today."

"She ran super. Alex did a great job getting her out of the gate. She's been pretty flawless on the Poly up to now. In California we had a hard time finding a race for her, so we nominated her here. I'm not sure about the Kentucky Oaks. I'd prefer to run her back on synthetic somewhere."
